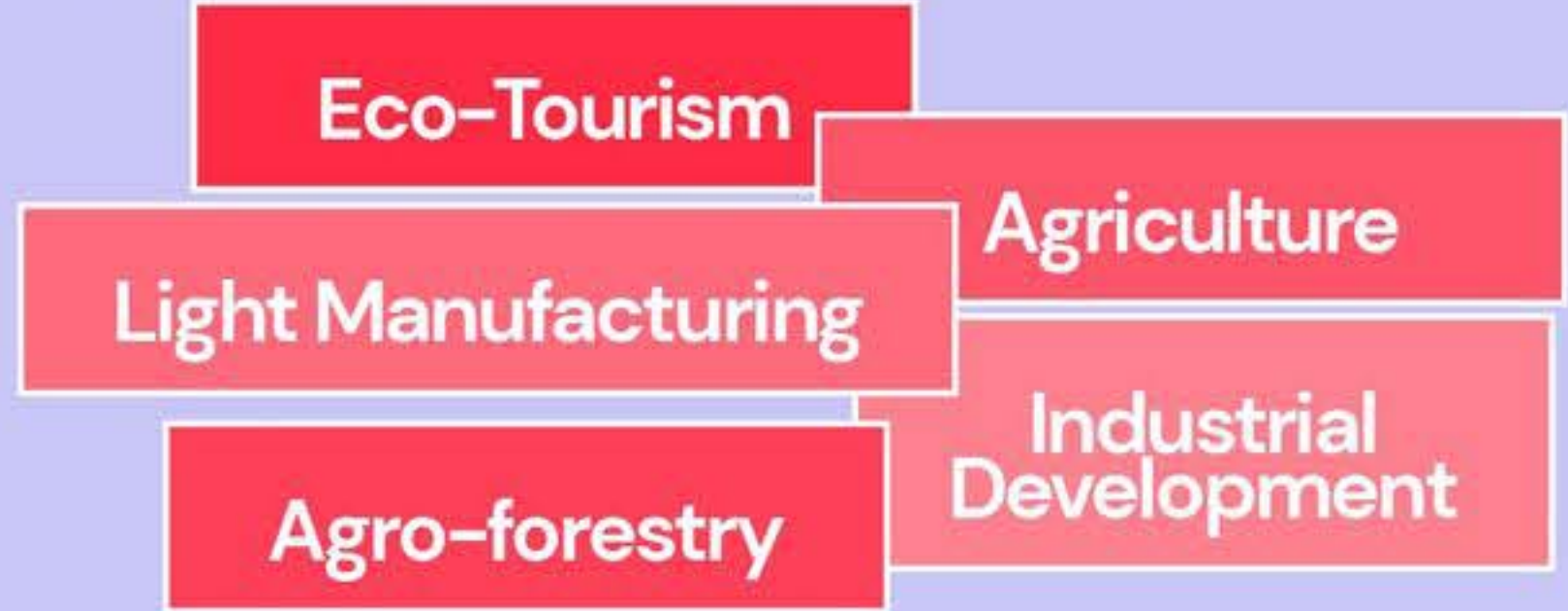

# INCENTIVES

- Fiscal Incentives**
1. Cost of all types of approved infrastructure project with public use is given 10% tax credit which would run 3 years the expiration of BOI or PEZA Incentives and 3 years for non-BOI/PEZA registered industries
  2. Provincial share of real property tax, 35% waived for the first 7 years.
- Non-Fiscal Incentives**
1. Coverage of line government agencies
  2. One-stop documentation center (for simplified documentation procedures)
  3. Consistent support for industrial peace
  4. Other as may be determined by the Board
